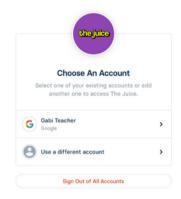


#### **GETTING STARTED GUIDE**

It's easy to get started using The Juice! Follow the steps to explore how to use The Juice's teacher portal.

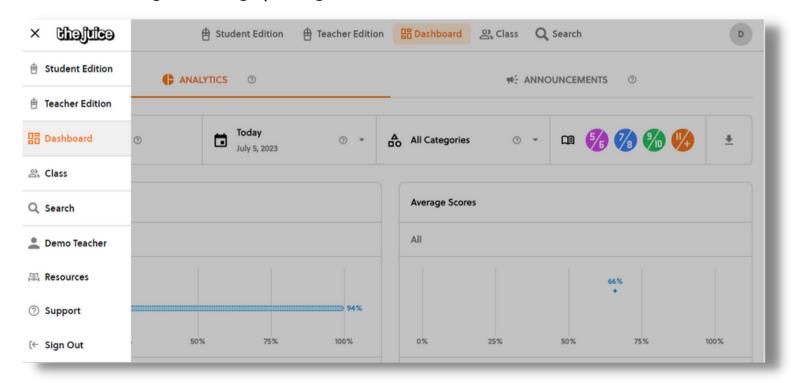
### **LOGGING IN**

If you have already signed in for the first time using your LMS, you can sign into the Juice by visiting <a href="https://secure.thejuice.news/sign-in">https://secure.thejuice.news/sign-in</a> and selecting "Login with your School's LMS Credentials." Your school account should appear and you can select it to login.



### **NAVIGATING THE JUICE**

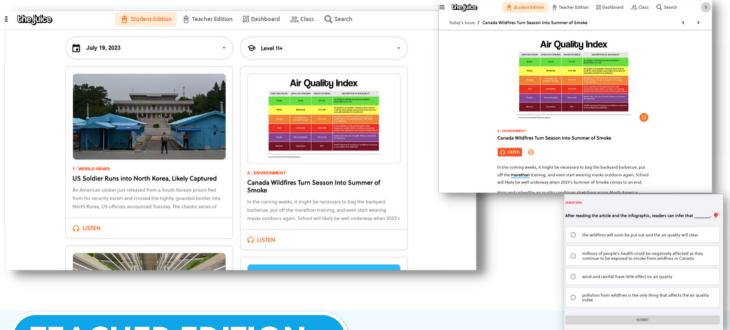

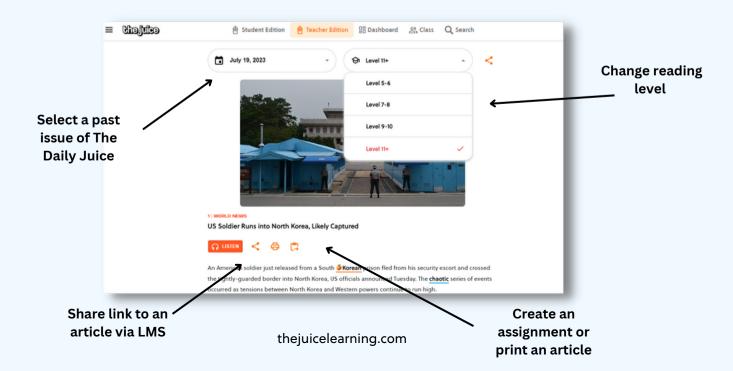
# **STUDENT EDITION**

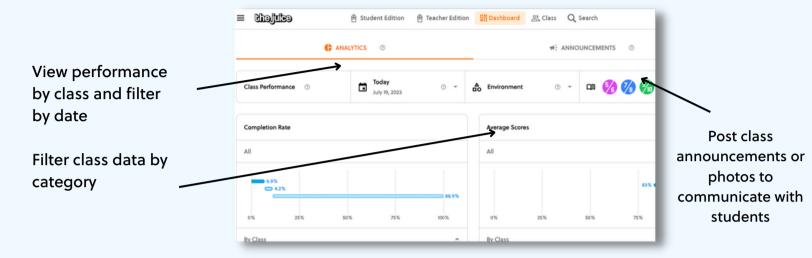




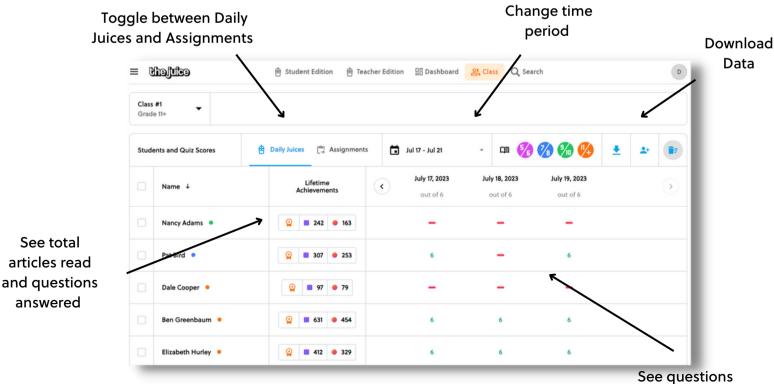

# **DASHBOARD**

After you sync your classes through your LMS, your students should appear on the "Class" tab. Change from one class view to another and click "LMS sync classes" to retrieve your most recent LMS roster changes. Please note, any changes you make to your roster must be done on your LMS and will take 24 hours to sync to The Juice.

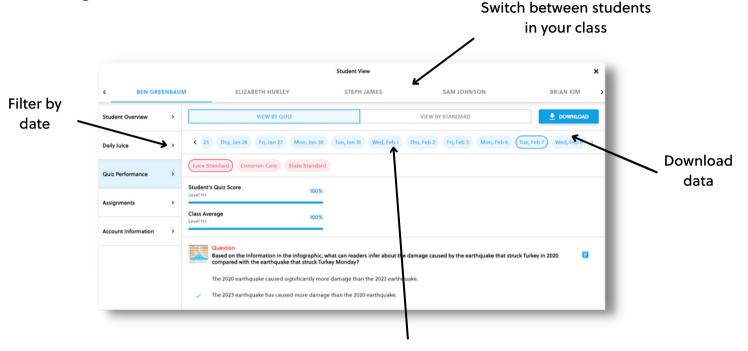

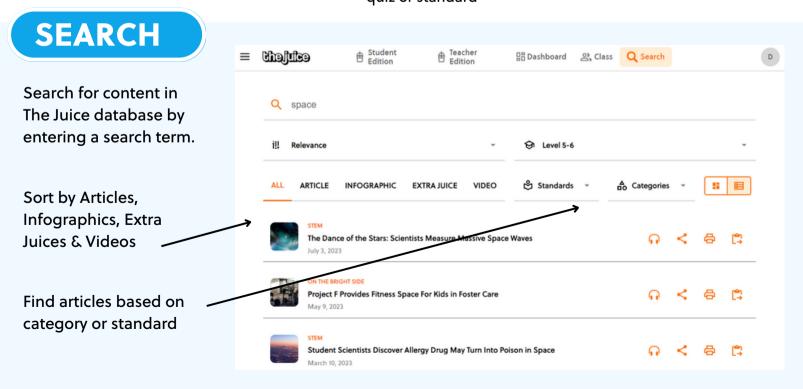


#### **Individual Student Data**

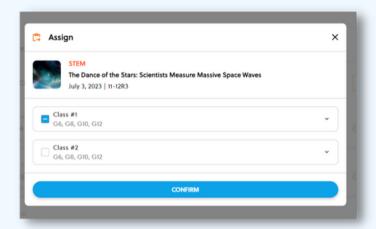
View by performance by quiz or standard

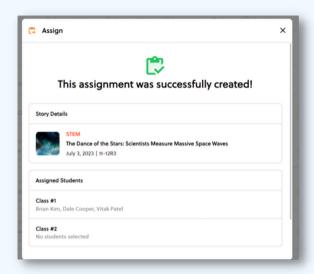




#### **Creating Assignments**

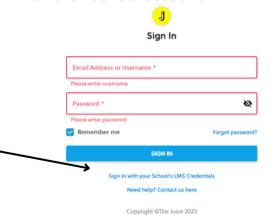




# **STUDENT SIGN ON**
