


GETTING STARTED GUIDE

It's easy to get started using The Juice! Follow the steps to explore how to use The Juice's teacher portal.


LOGGING IN

If you have already signed in for the first time using your LMS, you can sign into the Juice by visiting <https://secure.thejuice.news/sign-in> and selecting "Login with your School's LMS Credentials." Your school account should appear and you can select it to login.




NAVIGATING THE JUICE

Use both the primary navigation menu at the top of your screen or the hamburger menu to navigate between the different pages. You will also find a list of helpful resources including FAQs, teacher materials, lesson guides and graphic organizers under the "Resources" tab.




STUDENT EDITION

View articles from The Daily Juice by clicking on the "Student Edition" tab. Filter by date and grade level. You can also view the built-in supports and assessment questions in each article by clicking on an article to view.



TEACHER EDITION

View the Daily Juice articles and answers to assessment questions by clicking on the "Teacher Edition" tab. You can also print specific articles or create assignments in the Teacher Edition.




DASHBOARD

CLASS

After you sync your classes through your LMS, your students should appear on the "Class" tab. Change from one class view to another and click "LMS sync classes" to retrieve your most recent LMS roster changes. Please note, any changes you make to your roster must be done on your LMS and will take 24 hours to sync to The Juice.








STUDENT SIGN ON
